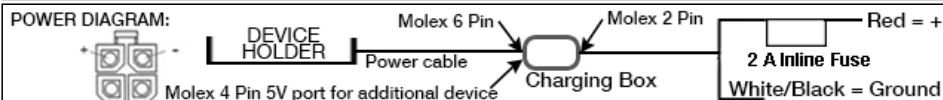

Power Rating: Input Voltage: 10-30 VDC, 1.1A / Output Voltage: 5 VDC, 2A.

Wiring: Follow the diagram below. Route the wire from the holder behind the dashboard and connect it to a power source; White or Black to ground or the vehicle chassis, and Red via the 2A in-line fuse to a positive power source. Professional installation is recommended.

Attention: Carefully read all instructions and review the images before installing this product.



1. Unscrew the screw in the center of the holder and remove the holder from the Tilt Swivel base plate.



2. Place the Tilt Swivel base plate over the matching holes in your mounting bracket (demo ProClip mount shown in picture). Attach the base plate by using the applicable screws enclosed - self-tapping screws if the mount has small holes or machine screws with nuts if the mount has larger holes. Place the holder onto the Tilt Swivel base plate and attach it with the center screw. Adjust the holder to the preferred position and tighten the screw firmly. Then loosen the screw slightly for easier angling and /rotation of the holder.



3. To insert the device into the holder:
Slide the device down into the holder.

To remove the device from the holder: Slide the device up and out.



4. The holder in place.
